

Types of Vision

UNIVERSAL VISION:

God has given all Christians certain mandates. One of them is to build His Kingdom through making disciples. This includes evangelizing the lost, establishing the young, and equipping the mature to do the same. This process is called "Spiritual Multiplication."

UNIQUE VISION:

While all Christians have this universal vision to embrace, God has a unique plan for each and every individual as well. He has designed everyone with differing strengths, talents, spiritual gifts, interests, and personalities by which to fulfill His plan.

How do I know His plan for me?

1. Look up!

Discovering God's mission for your life involves walking with Him daily. (John 15)

2. Look around!

What are the needs in the world around you? What gets your attention? (Matthew 9:36)

3. Look in!

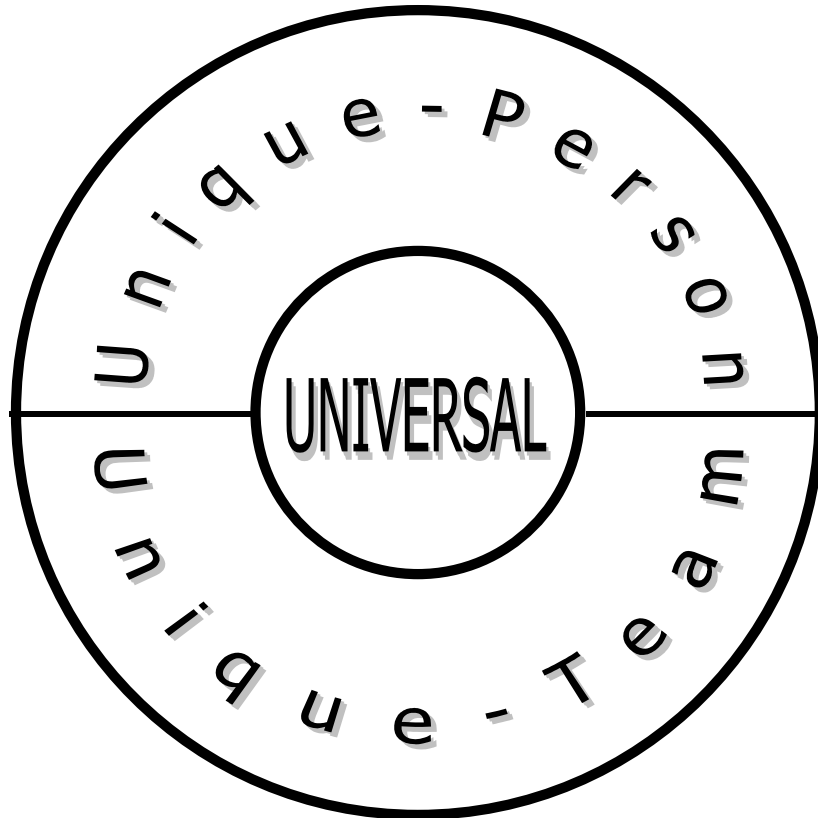
Realize your God-given uniqueness (Psalm 139). Consider how God could use those to further His cause. Go through the SHAPE exercise.

4. Begin with the end in mind!

One key ingredient in having personal vision is knowing where you want to finish. Think about the end of your life, what you want to have accomplished and what you want others to say about your life.

- How each person would fulfill universal vision
- S.H.A.P.E.

Team

- Developed same as unique/ personal vision
- A group of people committed to a common vision
- Same as unanimous vision
