

MAPS Structure for Discipleship Groups

Discipleship Groups should be planned with this general structure in mind. The time allotment and order of these sections may vary each time based on the needs of the group. The goal, however, is that each of these areas is being thought for and emphasized in our discipleship groups on a consistent basis. This is true for both staff led and student led discipleship groups.

M – Mission

- Sharing updates on personal ministry
- Discussing evangelism / discipleship strategy
- Discussing campus ministry strategy
- Discussing recruitment
- Discussing / praying for World Missions

A – Accountability

- Over spiritual disciplines
- Over moral issues (purity, speech, etc...)
- Over applications from last week's Discipleship Group

P – Prayer

- In the form of worship, confession, or supplication
- For one another, other people, ministry events
- Could involve music, psalms, hymns, or written prayers (Valley of Vision)

S – Scripture

- Teaching / Discussing Biblical doctrines and principles
- Asking discussion oriented questions to promote self-discovery
- Discussing Biblical principles from outside books / articles
- Making personal applications appropriate to the group
